Taxpayer Impact Statement

Texas Government Code §551.043 requires a governmental body to include a taxpayer impact statement on each meeting notice at which the governmental body will discuss or adopt a budget. The taxpayer impact statement must: for the median-valued homestead property, include a comparison of the property tax bill in dollars pertaining to the property for the current fiscal year to an estimate of the property tax bill in dollars for the same property for the upcoming fiscal year if the proposed budget is adopted.

Brazos CAD does not levy property taxes, and if Brazos CAD adopts the proposed budget, it will not directly impact property tax bills. However, appraisal district budgets are funded by the taxing units located in the appraisal district, and changes in the appraisal district budget may influence the budgets of taxing units that do levy property taxes
